1. The Resurrection **CHANGED** everything for Christ's disciples.

2. Jesus never accepted a **HALF-HEARTED** commitment.

3. There was a man who was **FULLY COMMITTED** before the Resurrection. (Mtt. 27:57-60)
 - A. He was a man of **POWER** and **WEALTH**. (Mk. 15:43; Mtt. 27:57)

 - B. He was a disciple, but a **COVERT** disciple. (Jn. 19:38)

 - C. He was a **FEARFUL** follower. (Jn. 19:38)

 - D. He took his stand with Jesus and **RISKED EVERYTHING**. (Mk. 15:43)

 - E. He took his stand with Jesus at the **DARKEST HOUR**.

4. Jesus asks for a **TOTAL COMMITMENT** from you.
