## **Pursuing Holiness**

<sup>15</sup> " If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother.
<sup>16</sup> But if he does not listen to you, take one or two more with you, so that BY THE MOUTH OF TWO OR THREE WITNESSES EVERY FACT MAY BE CONFIRMED.

<sup>17</sup> *If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.* 

<sup>18</sup> Truly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven. <sup>19</sup> "Again I say to you, that if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven. <sup>20</sup> For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst." Matt 18:15-20

## 1. God <u>DISCIPLINES</u> sin. (Act. 5:1-11; I Cor. 11:28-30)

- 2. The Lord <u>REQUIRES</u> the church to discipline sin in its midst. (Rev. 19:7)
- 3. Jesus gives a four-step process to promote <u>HOLINESS</u> in the church.
  - a. Go <u>PRIVATELY</u> to another Christian who is sinning. (vs. 15)
  - b. Take several others along as <u>CONFIRMATION</u>. (vs. 16)
  - c. Share the situation with the <u>CHURCH</u>. (vs. 17a)
  - d. <u>REMOVE</u> the <u>UNREPENTANT</u> sinner from the church. (vs 17b)
- 4. The goal is <u>RESTORATION</u>, not <u>REMOVAL</u>.
- 5. Church discipline is simply following what God has <u>ALREADY</u> <u>DECREED</u>. (vs. 18-19)
- 6. Confronting rebellious sin carries all the <u>AUTHORITY</u> of Christ Himself. (vs. 20)
- 7. Do not take communion if you are not right with <u>GOD</u>, or other <u>BELIEVERS</u>.
