²⁹ As they were leaving Jericho, a large crowd followed Him. ³⁰ And two blind men sitting by the road, hearing that Jesus was passing by, cried out, "Lord, have mercy on us, Son of David!" ³¹ The crowd sternly told them to be quiet, but they cried out all the more, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us!" ³² And Jesus stopped and called them, and said, "What do you want Me to do for you?" ³³ They *said to Him, "Lord, we want our eyes to be opened." ³⁴ Moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes; and immediately they regained their sight and followed Him. - 1. Jesus is always motivated by **COMPASSION**.
 - A. Jesus is never TOO BUSY to serve needy people.
 - B. People MATTER to God. (vs. 31)
- 2. Jesus gives a command performance of **GREATER** THINGS to come.
 - A. Jesus ends a lengthy teaching session with proof of His <u>AUTHORITY</u>.
 - B. Christ's miracles were a preview of a <u>PERFECT ETERNITY</u>. (I Cor. 2:9; Rom. 8:18; Col. 3:1; Heb. 11:13-16; Rev 21 & 22)
- 3. The blind men **ILLUSTRATE** what it **MEANS** to be a Christian.
 - A. They believed Jesus was the MESSIAH. (vs. 30)
 - B. Jesus did a <u>SUPERNATURAL</u> <u>WORK</u> for them.
 - C. Their faith in Christ leads to <u>DISCIPLESHIP</u>. (vs. 34)
